Sarge Gary Moll shared he had not fined Rotarians for not wearing their Rotary pins at meetings. He did however strongly encourage Rotarians to wear their pins during their daily work, as well as at meetings, to make people aware of the people and faces that are Rotary in their communities. Children's Services

Del Dunlap introduced Dave Boyer, Director of Muskingum County Children's Services. Boyer has led his team in developing what Del described as one of the premier programs in the state. Boyer's influence and efforts reach beyond the Children's Services program as he has developed and enhanced community partnerships and collaborations effecting the entire community for the better. Boyer leads a team of 97 people who he described as "passionate about protecting children." In their work there is no margin for error. Some of the contributing factors that lead to child abuse situations include mental health, financial crisis, people not equipped to handle children, drugs and alcohol. He explained their work calls for social workers and other associates to "behave boldly" when addressing potential cases of abuse, neglect and/or abandonment. Children's Services includes the Assessment Unit, Intervention Unit, Protection and Permanency Unit, Avondale Youth Center, and Data & Quality Improvement Unit. Some impressive numbers Boyer shared include an increase in staff retention from 48% in 1996 to 81% in 2008; 18% of children placed in local homes in 1996 to 97% in 2008; 17 foster homes in 1996 to 65 in 2008; and 3,922 children served in 1996 to 6,017 in 2008.

President John thanked Mr. Boyer for his enthusiastic and passionate presentation and presented a check for \$250 for Random Acts of Kindness to Children's Services to support their Comfy Bags project.
