Program Notes

Clay Lattimer introduced our program which was presented by Lolly Ravak and Cindy Voorhies. Lolly is the RLF Loan Administrator for Ohio Mid-Eastern Government Association (OMEGA) and Cindy is the Director of the Small Business Development Center serving Muskingum, Guernsey and Belmont Counties.

Lolly explained OMEGA is a state-certified Regional Planning and Development Organization representing the local governments of Belmont, Carroll, Columbiana, Coshocton, Guernsey, Harrison, Holmes, Jefferson, Muskingum and Tuscarawas counties. The Revolving Loan Fund (RLF) program offers low interest loans to businesses in conjunction with bank financing. RLF funds are used in the event that full financing cannot be obtained from a bank, or to fill the gap between the bank's participation and the borrower's cash contribution. The RLF program cannot provide 100% financing for a project. Thus far, the program has loaned \$4.3 million in 10 counties, helped 70 businesses, and created or retained 1,010 jobs since 1992.

Ohio Small Business Development serves the same 10 counties as OMEGA and Cindy serves Muskingum, Guernsey and Belmont Counties. The Small Business Development Center provides services to assist small businesses with advising, assistance, training and development and networking. Through this program interested individuals can gain the assistance needed to move through all stages of business development – from a new idea, through start-up, development and into growth and

expansion. The most important step is developing the business plan which Cindy defined as the road map to success. A financial analysis is done, budgets prepared, assistance with accounting and tax preparation, marketing advise, record keeping and a host of other integral areas for business success.

A Business Growth Summit is scheduled for May 8 at Zane State College where SBA reps will be available and a stimulus package update will be presented.
