### Announcements

Rick Emmert discussed the upcoming Arbor Day tree distribution project. This is our 12<sup>th</sup> year where free trees are distributed to every elementary student in Muskingum County. This year, in conjunction with the Muskingum Soil and Water Conservation District, 9500 Eastern White Pine trees will be packaged and distributed. We also thank AEP for purchasing the trees.

Rick is asking for volunteers to help both days. On April 29<sup>th</sup>, sorting and bundling will occur starting at 9:00 a.m. at FoxFire High School. Following our meeting on April 30<sup>th</sup>, the trees will be taken to the area schools. Members were asked to sign up or contact Rick for details.

### Program

Michele Sheridan, the president-elect of the Ohio State University Rotaract Club, was with us this morning. She shared information on the Bio



Sand Water Filter project in which she participated. "Clean Water for Peru" is an international service project.

The project funds the construction and distribution of bio sand water filters throughout the Latin American country. It is estimated that over 20% of the Peru population has unsafe drinking water. The water they normally drink comes from large water trucks. The source of this water may be nearby polluted rivers so it is not surprising that half the children in this poor country suffer from diarrhea and over 1/3 of these children have intestinal parasites.

Michele's project helps provide money for the construction of 4 feet high sand filters. The construction process is local which also provides jobs and trade skills for the general population. The filters remove approximately 90% of bacteria, viruses, parasites, and sediment from water thus providing a safe and clean drinking source. The cost for each of these filters is \$125, much of which is user selection and training. Not every household or residence is provided a filter, so there might be one that serves large numbers of people.

Our club provided Michele with \$1000 in support of this project and combined with other funds, her group was able to fund 28 filters. Congratulations, on this great humanitarian effort!
